## *Eligibility Requirements for Accelerated Courses 2008-2009*

### **Accelerated English and Accelerated Reading**

Eligibility for Accelerated English is based on a combination of outcomes of the Readiness Test and the average of the First, Second, and Third Nine-Week grades, and the student's most recent MCT score. The student must receive at least **7 of a possible 9 points** based on the following scale:

<b>Most Recent MCT (Reading or Language)</b>	<b>Readiness Test</b>	<b>Average of First Three (3) Nine Weeks</b>
Advanced = 3 points	94 – 100 = 3 points	94 – 100 = 3 points
Proficient = 2 points	85 – 93 = 2 points	85 – 93 = 2 points
Basic = 1 point	75 – 84 = 1 point	75 – 84 = 1 point

### **Accelerated Mathematics**

Eligibility for Accelerated Mathematics is based on a combination of outcomes of the Readiness Test, the average of the First, Second, and Third Nine-Week grades, and the student's most recent MCT score. The student must receive at least **7 of a possible 9 points** based on the following scale:

<b>Most Recent MCT (Math)</b>	<b>Readiness Test</b>	<b>Average of First Three (3) Nine Weeks</b>
Advanced = 3 points	94 – 100 = 3 points	94 – 100 = 3 points
Proficient = 2 points	85 – 93 = 2 points	85 – 93 = 2 points
Basic = 1 point	75 – 84 = 1 point	75 – 84 = 1 point
