Transition back to National School Lunch Program (NSLP)

The nationwide waiver that allowed all children to eat free will expire 6/30/22. Therefore, we will return to traditional meal pricing with students paying based on their eligibility (Free/Reduced/Paid). Students not approved for Free meals will need to be prepared to pay for meals, beginning with the first day of school. Parents will have to complete and submit a 22/23 Free/Reduced Meal Application if they would like to see if their student(s) qualify based on household income.

PLEASE NOTE-In the past years, the first 30 days of the school year carryover status from the previous school year applied. Many families may have chosen to not submit the meal application these past couple of years, so that 30-day carryover will not be applicable to those families. They will need to complete and be approved for free meals, or be prepared to pay on the first day.

How can a parent put funds into their child's cafeteria account?

- On-line at myschoolbucks.com
The payment portal opens July 18th.
The link is on the district website -> Departments -> Child Nutrition
Parents must have the child's MSIS number
- Cash or Check (One check per child is required)

How do parents qualify for Free/Reduced Meals?

- The fastest way is to complete the application on-line at myschoolapps.com.
The school meals application portal opens July 1st.
- Paper applications will be available at the central office and in school offices after July 1st.
- Return one application per family.

How and when do parents get notified of Free/Reduced eligibility?

- Eligibility notification letters are mailed out the day after the application gets processed.

How long does it take for the application to get processed?

- Online applications are processed within a day of the parent completing the application.
- Paper applications are processed anywhere between 3 to 30 days. It can take longer if the application is determined to be incomplete.

Can a parent call or email the CN office to get application status?

- Yes. A parent can contact the CN office to get meal eligibility or any other Child Nutrition information.
