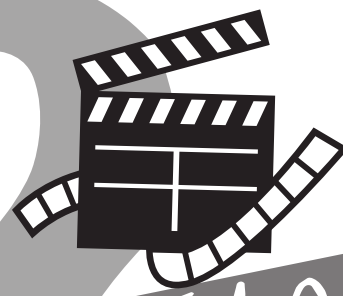

- \*You are NOT here to play on your phone, sleep, play computer games.

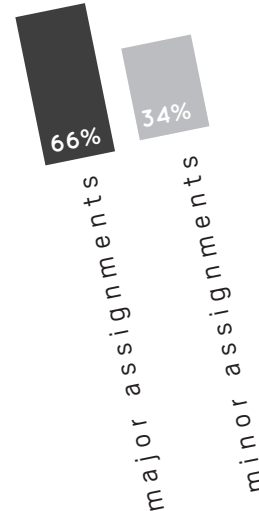
### RESPONSIBILITY
