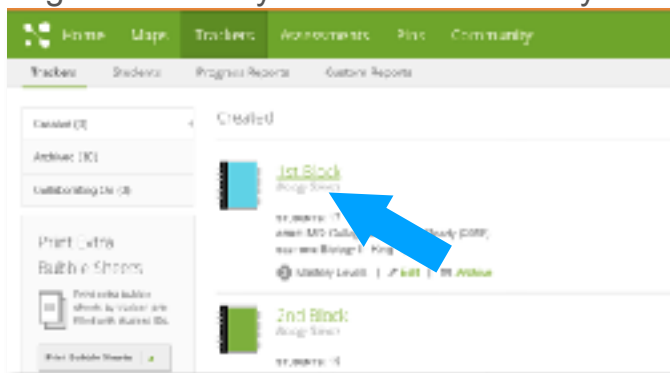
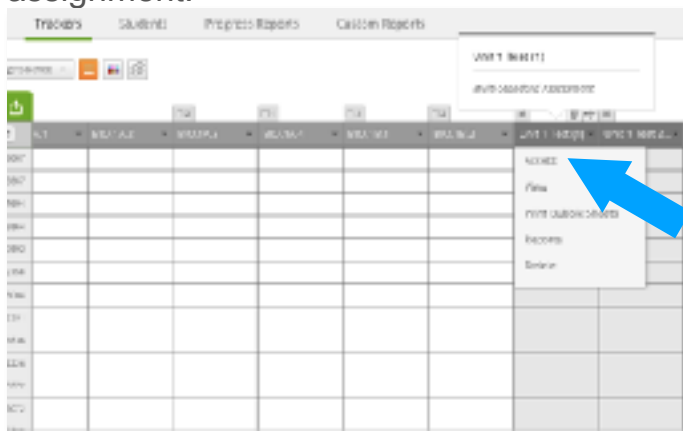


How to Deliver an Assignment Through Canvas

1. Log in to MasteryConnect and select your **tracker**.



2. Select the assessment you want to setup in Canvas. Click on **Assess** under that assignment.



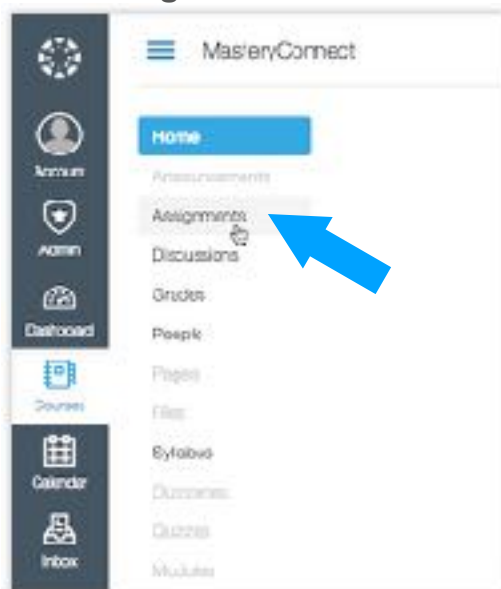
3. In the window that opens, click **Assess** again.



4. Copy the **URL** in the window.



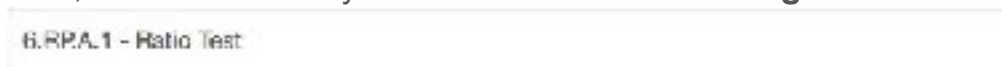
5. Log in to Canvas and open the course to which you would like to add the assessment.
6. Click **Assignments**.



7. Click the **Add Assignment** button.



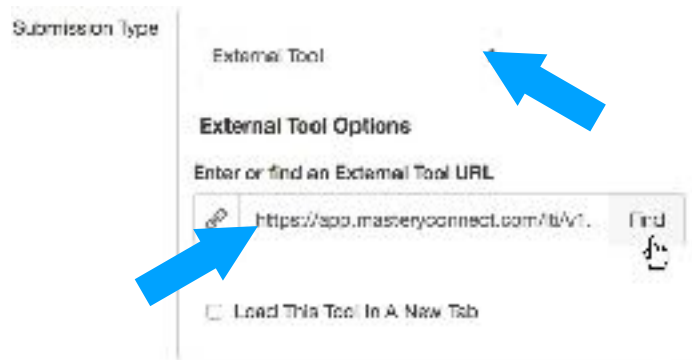
8. Now, enter the title of your assessment in the **Assignment Name** box.



9. In the **Points** box, enter the total points available for the assessment. This needs to match the points of the assessment that you're linking to in MasteryConnect.



10. Click the **Submission Type** drop-down list, and select **External Tool**. Next, click **Find** and select the MasteryConnect LTI connection. Leave the box **Load This Tool In a New Tab** unchecked.


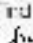

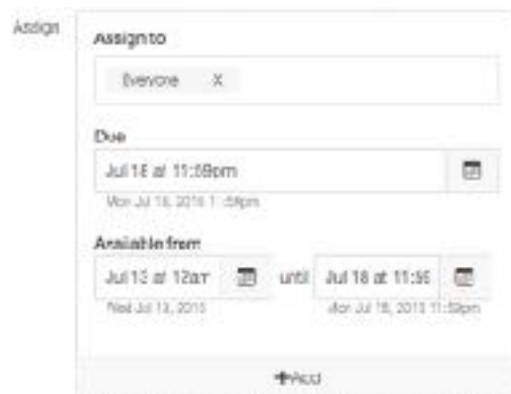

13. When you are ready for students to test, you can have them open LockDown Browser or any browser, login to Canvas, navigate to the module where you have added the assignment, and have them test. There are no specific settings for LockDown Browser. Keep in mind, this won't function as a true LockDown quiz, but should limit students some from navigating to other sites.
