HOW TO SETUP PRINTER USING IP ADDRESS

Step 1:

- 1. Select "Launch Pad" from the Dock
- 2. Select "Self Service"
- 3. Then, click "Install" option for Kyocera Drivers.



4. Close "Self Service".

Step 2:

1. Find IP Address located on front of printer.



- 2. Open "System Settings" from the Dock. (Was called System Preferences)
- 3. Select, Printers & Scanners (Bottom of the list).
- 4. Click "Add Printer, Scanner, or Fax..."
- 5. Select the "Globe/IP" icon.
- 6. Type your IP address from printer. Ex. 10.xx.xx.x
- 7. For Protocol, select "Line Printer Daemon LPD"
- 8. In the "Name" text box, type the desired, ex. James Office.
- 9. In the "Use" text box, it will select the driver for the printer you are installing.



- 10. Click"Add".
- 11. Select Duplex Printer if the option exists.
- 12. Click"OK"
- 13. Setup is complete.
- 14. Restart System Settings.
- 15. Choose Select PDL from the bottom of the menu on the left.
- 16. Choose you printer you just installed and click the KPDL drop down menu.
- 17. Select PCL and Apply.
