Science Vocabulary:

1. Rock cycle: the creation, destruction, and recreation of rocks in a continuous cycle
2. Metamorphic rock-rock that forms when sedimentary rock or igneous rock are heated and squeezed, and the minerals get rearranged
3. Sedimentary rock- rock formed with sand, mud, and pebbles get pressed into layers
4. Igneous rock- rock that forms when melted rock cools and hardens
