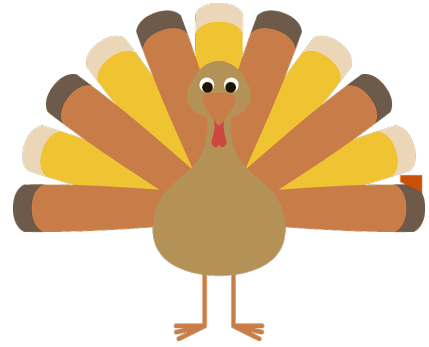

## NEW WORDS:

- sharecroppers- when one person farms another person's land, and the two share what is produced
- racial barriers- separated because of your race or what you look like
- discrimination- unfair treatment of one particular person or group of people because of their race; what they look like
- biplane- a plane with two pairs of wings
- international- another country or nation besides your own

## REVIEW WORDS:

- accomplishments- successfully completed goals or tasks
- fatigue- tiredness
- legend- a famous person who is known for a special talent or accomplishment
- disappeared- stopped being in sight
- navigator- a person who is responsible for directing to get from one place from another

# Science Vocabulary:

1. Mantle- the thickest layer of the Earth; semi-solid; always moving
2. Crust- the thinnest layer of the Earth; top layer
3. Outer Core- liquid and mostly metal; spins around the inner core
4. Inner Core- a solid metal ball; made of iron.
5. Igneous Rock- rocks formed from cooled and hardened magma.
6. Metamorphic Rock- rocks formed from heat and pressure.
7. Sedimentary Rock- when mud, sand, and pebbles get pressed in layers.
8. Rock Cycle- the series of processes that change one type of rock into another type of rock
