**Class of 2024—End of the Year Calendar**

- Friday, April 26** Deadline to notify Student Services of scholarship offers. Seniors need to complete the assignment in Canvas by April 26 to be recognized during the Class Day program. If you fail to complete this survey, your name will not be listed on the program!
- Monday, April 29-  
Tuesday, April 30** Book Check for all seniors. If you do not have your textbook, your name will be put on a list and you will not be allowed to take any exams, nor receive exam exemption until you have cleared up the textbook problem. The deadline for all books to be checked is April 30
- Thursday, May 2** Exam Review for “B” day classes
- Friday, May 3** Exam Review for “A” day classes
- Monday, May 6** “B” Day Exams. Seniors with MORE THAN 2 EXAMS on this day may defer any additional exams to Tuesday. YOU MUST MAKE PRIOR ARRANGEMENTS WITH THE TEACHERS TO TAKE ANY EXAM ON TUESDAY!
- Tuesday, May 7** “A” Day Exams. Seniors with MORE THAN 2 EXAMS on this day may defer any additional exams to Wednesday. YOU MUST MAKE PRIOR ARRANGEMENTS WITH THE TEACHERS TO TAKE ANY EXAM ON WEDNESDAY at 8:25 AM! **Seniors must report at 8:25 a.m. on Wednesday and all exams must be completed by 11 am.**
- Wednesday,  
May 8-10** Seniors will turn in MacBooks to the library before or after Class Day practice. Be prepared to pay any fines for damages.
- Wednesday, May 8** Class Day Practice – Seniors will report to the gym at 8:30AM to practice for Class Day.

- Thursday, May 9** 8:30 a.m. – All seniors must be in line for Class Day.

**Dress for senior girls – Solid white dressy attire (MC Dress code) and dress shoes**

- Friday, May 10** **Last day to turn in MacBooks to the library**  
The deadline for paying all fines and fees, turning in all textbooks and/or library books, and returning all school uniforms is 3:45 pm. **YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PICK UP YOUR CAP AND GOWN until all school business is cleared.**
- Wednesday, May 15** 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. - Seniors will pick up Caps and Gowns from the concession stand in the commons. Remember, you must have all your unfinished school business taken care of before you will be issued your cap and gown. There is a possibility that GPA’s will be ready so that honor graduates can be determined. If you anticipate being named an honor graduate, please pay **\$15 to your My School Bucks account**. “Distinction” graduates (blue cords) are those with a 90.00 to 93.99 GPA while “Special Distinction” graduates (orange cords) have a 94.00 GPA or higher.

**Thursday, May 16** Vowell will be setup in the Madison Central Commons from 9:30-12:00 pm to take cap and gown pictures. Information on how to sign up is on the Madison Central website.

**Friday, May 17** **8:30 a.m. – 10:30 a.m.** – Graduation practice for the Class of 2024 at the Mississippi Coliseum. Honor Cords will be available **AFTER PRACTICE** at a cost of \$15.00 – **CASH ONLY, EXACT CHANGE ONLY.** **GRADUATING SENIORS ARE REMINDED THAT ATTENDANCE AT GRADUATION PRACTICE IS MANDATORY FOR PARTICIPATION IN GRADUATION. If you do not attend practice or leave before practice is complete, you will be moved to the end of the lineup on Graduation Day.**

**Saturday, May 18** 10:00 a.m. – MCHS GRADUATION AT THE MISSISSIPPI COLISEUM. All seniors **MUST** report to the Mississippi Coliseum by **9:00 a.m.** Dress Code for Graduation: Girls – nice dress attire, dress shoes, cap, gown, and stole; Boys – khaki pants, dress shoes and socks, and a white dress shirt with a tie, cap, gown, and stole. Please be reminded that “proper dress and/or attire” is a part of the school policy for participation in graduation. **Neither caps nor gowns may be decorated, and the MC honor cords are the only cords allowed.**

**Other General Information:**

**The Madison County School District Graduation Policy**

Participation in any Madison County School Graduation is limited to those students who have completed ALL graduation requirements as specified by the MCSD School Board and the Mississippi State Board of Education. In addition, students participating in graduation shall comply with all rules and regulations regarding attendance at practice for graduation exercises, proper dress and/or attire, and any other regulation deemed appropriate.

**Graduate Services – Cap and Gown Orders**

Seniors who have not yet ordered a cap and gown may order online at [www.gradservicesmstn.com](http://www.gradservicesmstn.com) or must make individual arrangements with Herff Jones Graduate Services located at 232 W. School St. in Ridgeland (601-898-7883). You will need to pay the graduation fee with an assessed late fee. If you do not plan to participate in graduation, you will need to pay the diploma fee to Graduate Services. You will be able to pick up your diploma on Monday, May 20, at the school, provided all fees are paid.
