

STUDENT PARKING INFO

1. **Every student driving will be required to purchase a parking pass** which has not changed from prior years. The difference is now all parking spaces will be numbered and every student's parking space number will match their student ID and decal. This is being done for the safety of our students and faculty and will allow administrators to quickly identify those vehicles parked on campus daily.
2. As in previous years, you DO NOT have to join the PTO in order to select a parking space or purchase a parking decal. Parking decals are \$35. If you are not joining the PTO, you will be able to purchase and select your space when you pick up your schedule on a first-come, first-serve basis during your schedule pick-up time. Seniors will be able to select the front or back lot, Juniors and Sophomores will use the back lot only.
3. The dates to select your parking space are as follows:

July 17 Seniors purchasing any level of PTO membership & Decal (Either Lot)

July 18 Juniors purchasing any level of PTO membership & Decal (Back Lot Only)

July 19 Sophomores purchasing any level of PTO membership & Decal (Back Lot Only)

July 22 - Online parking selection closes at midnight

August 2 & 3 Schedule Pickup - Any student who wishes to purchase a parking pass only and not join the PTO will purchase their decal and select their space on a first-come/first serve basis during their schedule pick up time.

August 8 (First day of school) - Any student driving who has not previously purchased and received a parking decal needs to do so before start of class. Please bring drivers license, signed drug form, parking form and, if needed, \$35. You will be directed to park in a certain area on campus until you receive your decal.



YOU MUST

have your drivers license, signed drug consent form and parking decal form to pick up your decal.

*Sophomores not driving yet can reserve spot and pick up decal once they receive license.

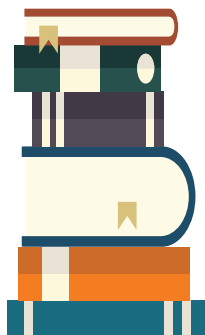
