I am reaching out to let you know that all Madison County Schools campuses are transitioning to Covid-19 Protocol Level 3 this Friday, August 13, 2021. As you know, this level requires masks to be worn by students, staff, and all people inside our school buildings.

Thankfully, beginning our school year with a soft start has mitigated the impact of Covid-19 in our schools so far. With the return of all students to campus together at the end of this week and based on projections of state and local case numbers, we feel that Covid cases in our schools will rise without an increase in precautionary measures.
