Dear MCS Families,

The last two years have been full of new and different challenges in our schools. I commend all of you, our parents, teachers, administrators, and students, for remaining committed to the importance of excellent teaching and learning throughout the Covid-19 pandemic. Together we have navigated protocols and policies designed to balance health concerns with normalcy. As case counts in our schools and in our community have steadily decreased in recent weeks, it is now time to return to pre-pandemic operations in Madison County Schools.

The Board of Education voted on Tuesday to end Covid-19 restrictions in our district. With this return to standard operations, visitors once again will be allowed at schools for lunch, programs, and activities as they were before the pandemic. Quarantine will no longer be required following exposure to Covid-19, but excused absences will continue for students who voluntarily choose to quarantine.
